

Checklist Criteria

Prerequisites for a multi-region main bicycle route for tourists

Before making a submission to verify whether the project can be funded, we recommend that you verify to what extent you meet the following prerequisites:

Criteria	Description
Course of the route	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> attractive landscape, interesting stretches along route few hills away from road traffic clearly marked entrance points (especially on circuit routes) with a combined information/rest/repair services/food centre with parking possibilities at intervals of maximum 20 cycling kilometers or a maximum of 75 cycling minutes at a normal pace. a direct route, avoiding detours combination of networks (connecting to other main routes)
Construction characteristics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Minimum 2.5 m wide asphalt surface (or similar) road crossings – avoid if possible, or alternatively a safe solution
Catchment area / demand potential	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> near to or within easy reach of urban centers not in a non-tourist region
Tourist offer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> critical number of bicyclist-friendly restaurants or alternatively overnight accommodation, bicycle repair services, sightseeing sights, and view points
Connections to public transportation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> connection of the bike path to public transportation at regular intervals of at least every 40 km (at every 2nd entrance point)
Marketing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> proof of the responsible tourist organizations readiness to provide marketing
Maintenance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> evidence of the management of ongoing maintenance and care
