How to participate?

Are you about to finish or have you recently (2023/24) finished your PhD, master or bachelor thesis at a research organization in Tulln?

Submit your abstract of maximum 300 words, pictures and charts formulated to suit a broader audience by the 20nd of May 2024, 12 p.m. to: technopol-tulln@ecoplus.at

FAQs

- Does the submitted proposal have to be part of a PhD-, Master-, Bachelor- or diploma thesis? Yes.
- Does my PhD-, Master-, Bachelor or diploma thesis has to be completed? No, but you need relevant findings and a minimum of 3 months previous employment. Each submission must be unique and must refer to research currently in progress or completed within the last 24 months.
- In what language can I submit my proposal?
 It can be submitted both in English or German.
- Does it make a difference, where I did my research work? Yes, the main part of it has to have been completed in Tulln.
- Does it matter which institution I am working for in Tulln?
 No.
- Is there a maximum age?
 Yes, candidates must be born after 01.01.1994
- Which submission format is required?

 There is no required format, PDF files are preferred. Pictures and graphics are explicitly welcome.
- Who is the jury?

The jury is a group of experts from the research and innovation scene, together with members of the Rotary Club. Please take into consideration that not every member has a scientific background! For this reason, one of the evaluation factors will be the level of common understanding.

How does the evaluation work?

The proposals have to fulfill all criteria determined by the jury. After having been submitted, the applications will be evaluated by the jury. The award ceremony will take place at Campus Tulln, on June 10th, 2024, 6 p.m. where the 3 honorees will present their work.

My work is confidential. Is it still possible to submit it?
 We advise you to clarify with your company or tutor how much information is possible to provide.
 We do not sign any confidentiality agreements.

The winners will be announced at the award's ceremony on June 10th, 2024

The jury's decision is final; no correspondence will be conducted with the participants; no participant lists or winner lists will be sent.
